

## Walkability/pedestrian safety checklist

1. Path Surface
  - 1a. No sidewalk or accessible path
  - 1b. Sidewalk is not continuous
  - 1c. Sidewalk is too steep
  - 1d. Sidewalk cracked or lifted
  - 1e. Other \_\_\_\_\_
  
2. Path Width/ Clearance
  - 2a. Inadequate sidewalk width (less than 6 feet wide)
  - 2b. Travel path obstructed by poles, signs, cars, shrubbery, items on sidewalk
  - 2c. Inadequate horizontal or vertical clearance
  - 2d. Other \_\_\_\_\_
  
3. Vehicular impacts to pedestrian pathway
  - 3a. Inadequate buffering from vehicular traffic
  - 3b. No ramp at driveway cut
  - 3c. Slope of driveway apron located in sidewalk
  - 3d. Width of driveway excessive

4. Pedestrian access at road crossings
  - 4a. No curb ramp at intersection or mid-block crossing
  - 4b. Single ramp used for two crossing directions
  - 4c. Curb ramp of substandard design or construction

5. Pedestrian safety at road crossing
  - 5a. Crossing inadequately marked, signed or maintained
  - 5b. Traffic speed/volume make crossing difficult
  - 5d. Wide crossing due to over-generous corner turning radius

6. Motorist behavior
  - 6a. Drivers exceed speed limit
  - 6b. Drivers do not yield for pedestrians in crosswalk or crossing

7. Miscellaneous
  - 7a. Walkway not well lighted
  - 7b. Dogs loose or other animal problems
  - 7c. Litter or trash around walkway
